

KERRIVAN

The first occurrence of the name Kerrivan in Blackhead is when Thomas Kerrivan and Elizabeth Lucretia Bradbury (protestants) are baptised there in January 1852. Their 4 children are baptised in May 1852.

Thomas and Elizabeth raise at least 6 children in Blackhead who then marry and have families there.

Mary Jane Kerrivan married Thomas Brien.(7 children)

Elizabeth Kerrivan married Patrick Power.(5 children)

James Kerrivan married Catherine Shortall.(4 children)

Thomas Kerrivan married Ellen Moore.(1 child)

Edward Kerrivan married Catherine Condon. (8 children)

William Kerrivan married Julia Wiseman.(4 children)

Thomas Kerrivan is listed as a planter in the 1871 directory. But by 1894 there are no Kerrivans listed for Blackhead. The families probably moved to St. John's.

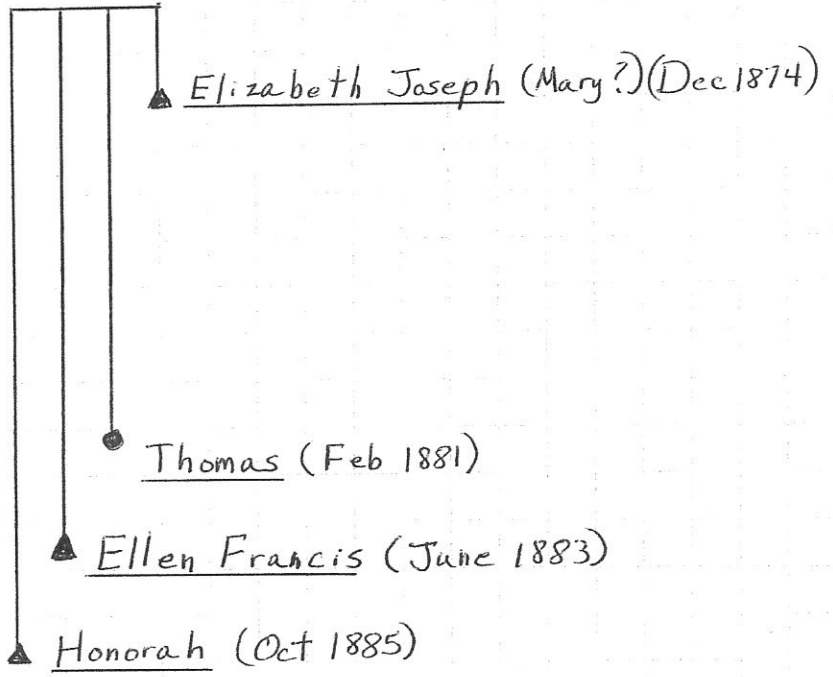
